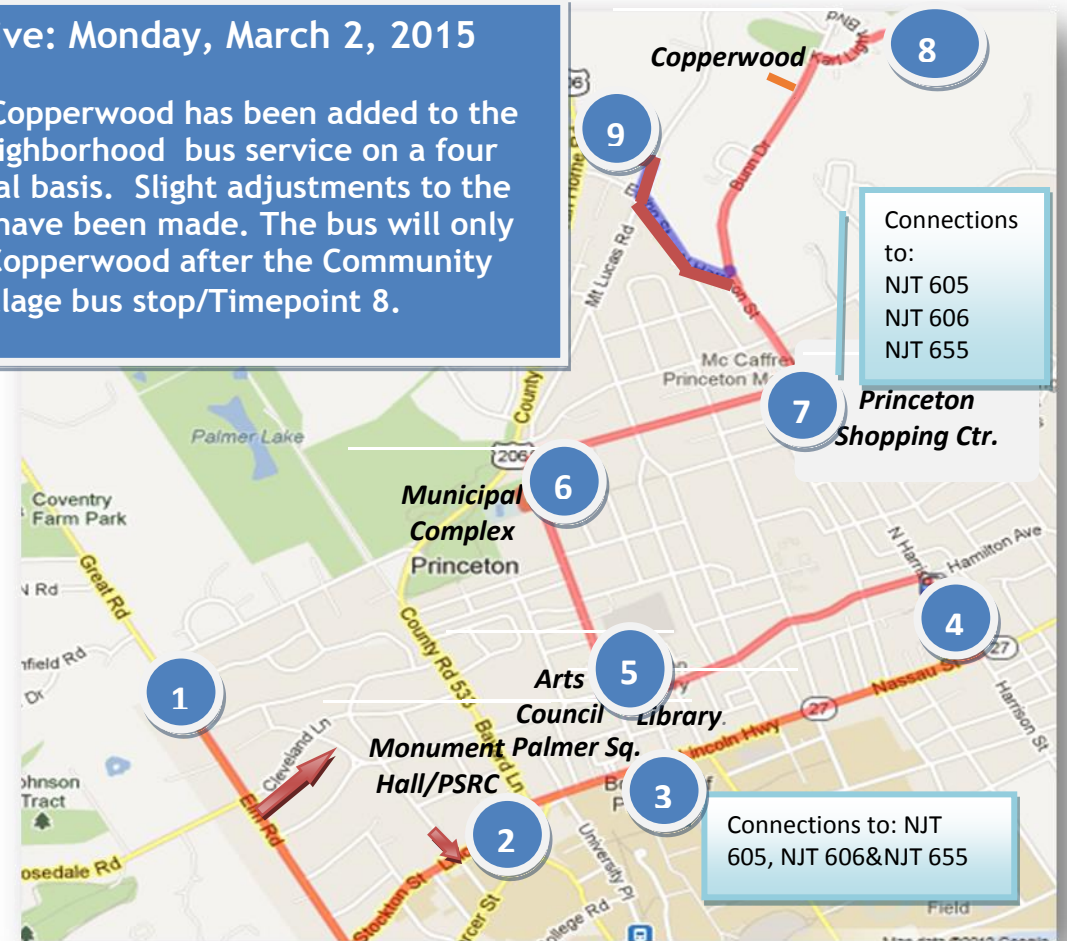

A stop at Copperwood has been added to the freeB Neighborhood bus service on a four month trial basis. Slight adjustments to the schedule have been made. The bus will only stop at Copperwood after the Community Village bus stop/Timepoint 8.



Monday – Saturday

freeB is a FREE neighborhood bus service funded by and serving the Princeton community. The bus is open and available to people of all ages.

The schedule lists locations along the route that are Timepoints for you to use to estimate the bus arrival time. The numbered circle on the schedule corresponds with the numbered circle on the map. If you are boarding between two Timepoints use the earlier Timepoint as your time guide. freeB will stop at any marked bus stop and anywhere along the route where it is safe to do so.
