

SEVERE WEATHER BUS SERVICE SCHEDULES

BANK OF AMERICA/MERRILL LYNCH HOPEWELL FACILITY

03/01/2019

When the weather turns nasty, regular bus service to and from the Hopewell facility and the Hamilton Rail Station may be impacted. A severe weather bus service plan may go into effect. There are two different bus schedules drafted to meet trains.

1. The bus schedule will be reduced, but timed to meet some of the regularly scheduled trains.
2. A further reduced bus schedule will go in to effect if NJTRANSIT trains are providing limited service. Severe Weather Bus Schedules

1. Reduced bus schedule, meeting some of the regular NJTRANSIT Trains

AM

If overnight or in the early morning, the weather makes for hazardous road conditions, the buses will meet the following trains if not canceled or combined with another train (i.e. 3813 & 3815 combined).

NYC/No. Jersey trains: 3813, 3815, 3817, 3821, 3823, 3825 and 3827. The buses will "load & go".

PM

If weather conditions deteriorate throughout the day and a reduced bus schedule is necessary for everyone's safety, the following schedule will be implemented.

2. Bus schedule to meet NJTRANSIT's NEC Severe Weather Schedule (Level 1 & 2)

NJTRANSIT Severe weather schedules MAY be implemented on the NEC, when:

Level 1 - snow is predicted to be 6 inches to a foot.

Level 2- snow is predicted to be over 1 foot. Ultimately they may suspend service all together.
